



THE RATING (FEES) REGULATIONS 1987

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 16th day of March 1987

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 81 (8) of the Rating Act 1967 and section 100A of the Judicature Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Rating (Fees) Regulations 1987.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1987.

2. Fees in respect of sale of land through High Court—(1) The fee payable to a Registrar of the High Court on the filing of a certificate of judgment for rates under section 81 (1) of the Rating Act 1967 shall be \$100.

(2) The fee payable to a Registrar of the High Court on the filing of an application for the sale of any land under section 81 (4) of that Act shall be \$400.

3. Revocation—The Rating (Fees) Regulations 1984* are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase from \$20 to \$100 the fee payable on the filing of a certificate of judgment for rates under section 81 (1) of the Rating Act 1967. They also increase from \$30 to \$400 the fee payable on an application for the sale of any land under section 91 (1) of that Act.
