PURSUANT to section 3 (2) of the Rates Rebate Act 1973, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Rates Rebate Order 1974.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1974.

2. Income limit—Section 3 of the Rates Rebate Act 1973 is hereby amended by omitting from subsection (1) (b) the expression “\$2,340”, and substituting the expression “\$2,800”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order increases from \$2,340 a year to \$2,800 a year the income of a ratepayer that is disregarded in calculating the amount of any rebate to which he is entitled under the Rates Rebate Act 1973.
