PURSUANT to section 3 (2) of the Rates Rebate Act 1973, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Rates Rebate Order 1975.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1975.

**2. Income limit**—(1) Section 3 (1) (b) of the Rates Rebate Act 1973 (as amended by clause 2 of the Rates Rebate Order 1974) is hereby further amended by omitting the expression “\$2,800”, and substituting the expression “\$3,400”.

(2) The Rates Rebate Order 1974\* is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order increases from \$2,800 to \$3,400 a year the income of a ratepayer that is disregarded in calculating the amount of any rebate to which he is entitled under the Rates Rebate Act 1973.
