PURSUANT to section 3 (2) of the Rates Rebate Act 1973, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Rates Rebate Order 1978.

2. Income limit—(1) Section 3 (1) (b) of the Rates Rebate Act 1973 (as amended by clause 2 of the Rates Rebate Order 1976) is hereby further amended by omitting the expression “\$3,760”, and substituting the expression “\$4,235”.

(2) The Rates Rebate Order 1976* is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order increases from \$3,760 to \$4,235 a year the income of a ratepayer that is disregarded in calculating the amount of any rebate to which he is entitled under the Rates Rebate Act 1973.
