THE RATES REBATE ORDER 1979

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 9th day of April 1979

Present:

THE RIGHT HON. R. D. MULDOON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 3 (2) of the Rates Rebate Act 1973, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. **Title**—This order may be cited as the Rates Rebate Order 1979.
2. **Initial contribution**—Section 3 (1) of the Rates Rebate Act 1973 (as substituted by section 3 (1) of the Rates Rebate Amendment Act 1978) is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (a) (i) the expression “\$50”, and substituting the expression “\$100”.
3. **Income limit**—Section 3 (1) of the Rates Rebate Act 1973 (as so substituted) is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (a) (ii) the expression “\$4,235”, and substituting the expression “\$4,850”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order increases the initial contribution of a ratepayer from \$50 to \$100, and increases from \$4,235 to \$4,850 a year the income of a ratepayer that is disregarded in calculating the amount of any rebate to which he is entitled.
