PURSUANT to the Reserve Bank of New Zealand Act 1964 and the Economic Stabilisation Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Regulations Revocation Order 1984.
 - (2) This order shall come into force on the 19th day of July 1984.
- **2. Regulations revoked**—The regulations specified in the Schedule hereto are hereby revoked.
