ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 26th day of July 1977

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Rotorua Trout Fishing Regulations 1971, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Rotorua Trout Fishing Regulations 1971\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Restrictions on methods of fishing**—(1) Regulation 16 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (c), and substituting the following paragraph:

“(c) Any line incorporating or containing wire, or lead or any other metal.”.

(2) Column 2 of the Fourth Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “wood,” and “rate of”.

These regulations prevent the use of fishing lines incorporating or containing wire, or lead or any other metal, within the Rotorua Trout Fishing District.
