## THE ROTORUA TROUT-FISHING REGULATIONS 1939, AMENDMENT NO. 2

At the Government House at Wellington, this 20th day of September, 1944

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Rotorua Trout-fishing Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 2.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Rotorua Trout-fishing Regulations 1939\* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October, 1944.
- 4. Regulation 35 of the principal regulations is amended by revoking the paragraph numbered (iii) of clause (1) thereof, and substituting the following paragraph:—
  - "(iii) Any leaden or other weight on or in connection with a line, including a weight embodied in the hook or other part of a fly, but excluding the weight of a lure consisting solely of a metal hook dressed in accordance with accepted practice so as to become an artificial fly."
