**THE ROTORUA TROUT-FISHING REGULATIONS 1939,
AMENDMENT NO. 4**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 30th day of
October, 1946

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Rotorua Trout-fishing Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 4.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Rotorua Trout-fishing Regulations 1939* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of November, 1946.

4. Regulation 36 of the principal regulations, as substituted by Regulation 4 of the Rotorua Trout-fishing Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 1, is revoked, and the following regulation substituted:—

“ 36. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in these regulations or contained in any license issued under these regulations, no person shall during the period commencing on the 1st day of November, 1946, and terminating on the 14th day of May, 1949, fish for, take, or kill trout by any means whatsoever in or from the Wairoa Stream between the Waterfalls and Lake Tarawera, or in the Wairua Stream and that portion of Lake Tarawera within an arc drawn from shore to shore having a radius of 200 yards from the centre of the meeting-line of the said Wairua Stream and lake, being waters in which trout fry have been placed.”
