Pursuant to the Fisheries Act, 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Rotorua Trout-fishing Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 5.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Rotorua Trout-fishing Regulations 1939* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the 15th day of October, 1947.
- 4. The principal regulations are amended by inserting, next following Regulation 37, the following regulation:
- "37A. No person shall cast, throw, or place, or permit to be cast, thrown, or placed, any rubbish or refuse or material of any kind into any waters or on any river-bed."
