PURSUANT to the Road User Charges Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**O R D E R**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Road User Charges (Time Licences) Order 1978.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1978.

**2 Off-road motor vehicles**—(1) The following class of motor vehicle is hereby added, as paragraph (1), to Licence Category A of the Second Schedule to the Road User Charges Act 1977:

	Vehicle Type Number
“(1) Trailer scrapers       .....       .....       .....       .....	70”.

(2) The following class of motor vehicle is hereby added, as paragraph (c), to Licence Category C of the Second Schedule to the Road User Charges Act 1977:

	Vehicle Type Number
“(c) Unregistered motor vehicles operated under trade plates       .....       .....       .....       .....	90”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order adds the following classes of vehicles to the Second Schedule to the Road User Charges Act 1977:

- (a) Trailer scrapers (Licence Category A):
- (b) Unregistered motor vehicles operated under trade plates (Licence Category C).

The Second Schedule specifies the vehicles that are to have time licences for the purposes of that Act.
