PURSUANT to the Road User Charges Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Road User Charges (Time Licences) Order 1978.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1978.

2 Off-road motor vehicles—(1) The following class of motor vehicle is hereby added, as paragraph (1), to Licence Category A of the Second Schedule to the Road User Charges Act 1977:

(2) The following class of motor vehicle is hereby added, as paragraph (c), to Licence Category C of the Second Schedule to the Road User Charges Act 1977:

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order adds the following classes of vehicles to the Second Schedule to the Road User Charges Act 1977: (a) Trailer scrapers (Licence Category A): (b) Unregistered motor vehicles operated under trade plates (Licence Category

C).

The Second Schedule specifies the vehicles that are to have time licences for the purposes of that Act.
