ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government Buildings at Wellington this 2nd day of April 1979

THE RIGHT HON. R. D. MULDOON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Road User Charges Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

—

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Road User Charges Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Road User Charges Regulations 1978* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 9th day of April 1979.

2. Form of distance and supplementary licences—(1) The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting form No. 1, and substituting the form No. 1 set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) Notwithstanding subclause (1) of this regulation, distance licences and supplementary licences that have been issued by an issuing officer before the day on which these regulations come into force may be displayed on a motor vehicle, and shall continue to have effect, as if these regulations had not been enacted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 9 April 1979, amend the Road User Charges Regulations 1978 by substituting a new form for distance and supplementary licences.

Licences issued before 9 April 1979 shall continue to have effect as if the form had not been changed.
