ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 28th day of January 1985

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Road User Charges Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Road User Charges Regulations 1978, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Road User Charges Regulations 1978* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) Subject to subclause (3) of this regulation, these regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of February 1985.

(3) In respect of any application under section 8 of the Road User Charges Act 1977 for a time licence, these regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1985.

2. Fees—Regulation 8 of the principal regulations is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Regulation 2 revokes regulation 8 of the principal regulations, which prescribes the administration fee payable on application for each licence pursuant to section 9 of the Act. As from 1 February 1985 in respect of distance and supplementary licences, and 1 April 1985 in respect of time licences, the administration fees for these licences are incorporated into the charges for those licences.
