RULE UNDER PART III OF THE INFANTS ACT, 1908.

GALWAY, Governor-General.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by the Infants Act, 1908, and of all other powers enabling him in this behalf, His Excellency the Governor-General of the Dominion of New Zealand doth hereby make the following rule.

R U L E.

Notwithstanding anything contained in the rules made under Part III of the Infants Act, 1908, on the 13th day of February, 1912, the Minister of Justice may from time to time direct in writing that any specified adoption records in any Court or Courts shall be transferred for safe custody to the office of the Registrar-General, and the person having the custody of any such specified records shall upon the receipt of such direction forthwith deliver the said records to the Registrar-General.

The Registrar-General shall be deemed to be the officer having the proper custody of any records entrusted to him in pursuance of any such direction.
