**THE RENTAL VEHICLE REGULATIONS 1939,

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Transport Act 1949, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Rental Vehicle Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Rental Vehicle Regulations 1939* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after clause (iii), the following clauses :—

- “ (iiiA) At the expiration of three years from the date
of issue of the licence, a further .. 4 0 0
- “ (iiiB) At the expiration of four years from the date
of issue of the licence, a further .. 4 0 0”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

The term of rental vehicle licences was extended from three years to five years by the Transport Amendment Act 1950. These regulations consequentially provide for payment of annual licence fees during each of the fourth and fifth years of licence, the fees being at the present annual rate.
