



**THE SAMOA AMENDMENT ACT COMMENCEMENT ORDER
1956**

A PROCLAMATION

WHEREAS by subsection (2) of section 1 of the Samoa Amendment Act 1956 it is provided that Parts I and II of that Act shall come into force on a date to be appointed for the commencement thereof by the Governor-General by Proclamation:

Now, therefore, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Willoughby Moke Norrie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby proclaim as follows:

1. This Proclamation may be cited as the Samoa Amendment Act Commencement Order 1956.

2. Parts I and II of the Samoa Amendment Act 1956 shall come into force on the 1st day of September 1956.
