**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to sections 300 and 504 of the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952, His Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following rules.

**RULES**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These rules may be cited as the Shipping (Anchors and Chain Cables) Rules 1972, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Shipping (Anchors and Chain Cables) Rules 1972\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal rules).

(2) These rules shall come into force on the 1st day of August 1986.

**2. Fees**—The principal rules are hereby amended by revoking rule 14 (as substituted by rule 2 of the Shipping (Anchors and Chain Cables) Rules 1972, Amendment No. 3), and substituting the following rule:

“14. Where the certifying authority is the Ministry of Transport, there shall be payable to the Secretary in respect of the services of a supervisor of tests a fee of \$65 per hour or part of an hour.”

**3. Revocation**—The Shipping (Anchors and Chain Cables) Rules 1972, Amendment No. 3 are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the rules, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These rules, which come into force on 1 August 1986, increase the fees payable under the Shipping (Anchors and Chain Cables) Rules 1972 for the services of a supervisor of tests from \$30 to \$65 an hour.
