

# THE SCIENTIFIC AND INDUSTRIAL RESEARCH (INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY) REGULATIONS 1989

#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 20th day of November 1989

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to section 15 of the Scientific and Industrial Research Act 1974, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Scientific and Industrial Research (Intellectual Property) Regulations 1989.
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- **2. Execution of documents**—For the purposes of section 12 (1) of the Scientific and Industrial Research Act 1974, any application or other document may be signed on behalf of the Crown by the Minister.
- **3. Revocation**—The Scientific and Industrial Research (Intellectual Property) Regulations 1986 are hereby revoked.

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations give the Minister the power to execute any document pertaining to intellectual property which belongs to the Crown pursuant to section 12 (1) of the Scientific and Industrial Research Act 1974.
