# THE SCIENTIFIC AND INDUSTRIAL RESEARCH (ALLOWANCES) REGULATIONS 1938.

## GALWAY, Governor-General.

### ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 26th day of October, 1938.

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Scientific and Industrial Research Act, 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Scientific and Industrial Research (Allowances) Regulations 1938.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made under the Scientific and Industrial Research Act, 1926, on the 6th day of June, 1927.\*
- 3. Regulation 2 of the said regulations is amended by adding, immediately after the word "Council" at the end of the regulation, the following words:—
- "A member of the Council or of any committee thereof using his own motor-vehicle for any of the aforesaid purposes may be paid a mileage allowance at such rate as the Minister approves."
