ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 26th day of  
October, 1938.

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Scientific and Industrial Research Act, 1926, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Scientific and Industrial Research (Allowances) Regulations 1938.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the regulations made under the Scientific and Industrial Research Act, 1926, on the 6th day of June, 1927.\*

3. Regulation 2 of the said regulations is amended by adding, immediately after the word " Council " at the end of the regulation, the following words :—

" A member of the Council or of any committee thereof using his own motor-vehicle for any of the aforesaid purposes may be paid a mileage allowance at such rate as the Minister approves."
