



**THE STRIKE AND LOCKOUT EMERGENCY REGULATIONS  
1939, AMENDMENT NO. 3**

**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington, this 23rd day of  
June, 1943

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Strike and Lockout Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Strike and Lockout Emergency Regulations 1939\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Regulation 5 of the principal regulations, as substituted by Regulation 3 of the Strike and Lockout Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 2, is hereby amended by omitting the words "notice in the *Gazette*", and substituting the words "writing under his hand".

3. Regulation 11 of the principal regulations, as substituted by Regulation 3 of the Strike and Lockout Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 2, is hereby amended by adding the words "Any member who without reasonable excuse (the burden of proving which shall be on him) fails to attend any such meeting of the Committee commits an offence against these regulations".

4. The principal regulations are hereby amended by adding the following regulation:—

"20. Subject to the provisions of these regulations, all the provisions of the Commissions of Inquiry Act, 1908†, shall apply as if every Emergency Disputes Committee set up under these regulations were a Commission under that Act."
