

SECURITIES ACT (TOWER LIFE (N.Z.) LIMITED) EXEMPTION NOTICE 1999

PURSUANT to the Securities Act 1978, the Securities Commission gives the following notice.

NOTICE

- 1. Title, commencement, and expiry—(1) This notice may be cited as the Securities Act (Tower Life (N.Z.) Limited) Exemption Notice 1999.
 - (2) This notice comes into force on notification in the Gazette.
 - (3) This notice expires on the close of 29 October 1999.
- **2.** Interpretation—(1) In this notice, "Act" means the Securities Act 1978.
- (2) Any term or expression that is not defined in this notice, but that is defined in the Act, has the meaning given to it by the Act.
- **3. Exemption**—Tower Life (N.Z.) Limited and every person acting on its behalf are exempted from sections 37 and 37A (1)(c) of the Act in respect of offers of life insurance policies.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the notice, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This notice comes into force on its notification in the Gazette and expires on 29 October 1999.

The notice exempts Tower Life (N.Z.) Limited from sections 37 and 37 Λ (1) (c) of the Securities Act 1978 in the case of offers of life insurance policies. The effect of the notice is that the company is temporarily exempt from the prospectus provisions of the Act in the case of offers of life insurance policies.
