PURSUANT to the Law Practitioners Act 1955, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Solicitors Audit Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Solicitors Audit Regulations 1938* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. Clause (6) of regulation 6 of the principal regulations, as substituted by paragraph (c) of regulation 7 of the Solicitors Audit Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 2, and amended by regulation 2 of the Solicitors Audit Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 3, is hereby further amended by inserting, after the word "auditor", the words "and to the Secretary of the New Zealand Law Society".
