

# THE SOLICITORS AUDIT REGULATIONS 1938, AMENDMENT NO. 7

Pursuant to the Law Practitioners Act 1955, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

#### REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Solicitors Audit Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Solicitors Audit Regulations 1938\* (hereinafter referred to

as the principal regulations).

2. Subclause (6) of regulation 6 of the principal regulations (as substituted by paragraph (c) of regulation 7 of the Solicitors Audit Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 2, and amended by regulation 2 of the Solicitors Audit Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 3, and by regulation 2 of the Solicitors Audit Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 4) is hereby further amended by omitting the words "In each month", and substituting the words "In the month of January in each year not later than the twenty-fifth day of that month, and in each other month".

#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations amend the principal regulations so as to provide that in January in each year the monthly return of balances in trust accounts need not be made until the 25th day of the month.
