PURSUANT to section 303 of the Education Act 1989, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Student Allowances Regulations 1988, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Student Allowances Regulations 1988* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of January 1991.

2. Interpretation—(1) Regulation 2 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking paragraph (b) of the definition of the term “course of study”.

(2) Regulation 2 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by revoking paragraph (a) of the definition of the term “full-time programme”.

(3) Regulation 2 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by revoking paragraph (d) of the definition of the term “Professorial Board”, and substituting the following paragraph:

“(d) In relation to a teachers college, community college, or technical institute, means the Principal of that college or institute.”.

(4) Regulation 2 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by revoking the definition of the term “secondary school”.

(5) Regulation 2 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby further amended by omitting from the definition of the term “tertiary institution” the words “and, in relation to any person who attends a secondary school pursuant to section 96A of the Act, includes that secondary school”.

3. Applications—(1) Regulation 4 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “a secondary school or”.

(2) Regulation 4 (2) (a) of the principal regulations is hereby revoked.

4. Courses for disabled persons—(1) Regulation 6 (1) of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 3 of the Student Allowances Regulations 1988, Amendment No. 2) is hereby amended by omitting the words “secondary school or a”.

(2) Regulation 6 (2) (b) of the principal regulations (as so amended) is hereby amended by omitting the words “Principal of that secondary school or the”.

(3) Regulation 3 of the Student Allowances Regulations 1988, Amendment No. 2 is hereby consequentially revoked.

5. Basic grants established—(1) Regulation 15 (3) of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Student Allowances Regulations 1988, Amendment No. 3) is hereby amended by omitting the words “every single secondary student and”.

(2) Regulation 15 (4) of the principal regulations (as so substituted) is hereby amended by omitting the words “every secondary student and”.

(3) Regulation 15 (5) of the principal regulations (as so substituted) is hereby amended by omitting the words “secondary school or”.

(4) Regulation 15 (5A) of the principal regulations (as inserted by regulation 5 (3) of the Student Allowances Regulations 1988, Amendment No. 2) is hereby amended by omitting the words “a secondary school or”.

6. Period for which basic grant and independent circumstances grant payable—Regulation 17 (2) of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting the words “a secondary school or”;
- (b) By omitting the words “school or” where they secondly occur.

7. Award of basic grant and independent circumstances grant—

(1) Regulation 18 (1) (a) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “a secondary school or”.

(2) Regulation 18 (2) (a) of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 6 of the Student Allowances Regulations 1988, Amendment No. 2) is hereby amended—

- (a) By omitting the words “Principal of the secondary school concerned or the”;
- (b) By omitting from subparagraph (ii) the words “that Principal or”;
- (c) By omitting from subparagraph (iii) the words “that Principal or”.

8. Basic grant and independent circumstances grant payable in respect of full-time programmes only—Regulation 19 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “a secondary school or”.

9. Change in holder’s circumstances affecting entitlement—Regulation 23 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

- (a) By revoking paragraph (a);
- (b) By omitting from paragraph (b) the words “, in any other case”.

10. Withholding of payments under grant in certain circumstances—Regulation 24 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 2 of the Student Allowances Regulations 1988, Amendment No. 4) is hereby amended—

- (a) By revoking subclause (3) (a);
- (b) By omitting from subclause (3) the words “the Secretary or the Registrar, as the case may require,”, and substituting the words “the Registrar”.

11. Effect of reduction of gross income of full-time student—Regulation 24A (1) (a) of the principal regulations (as so substituted) is hereby amended by omitting the words “a secondary school or”.

12. Maximum tenure of basic grant and independent circumstances grant—Regulation 25 (1) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “(other than a secondary school student)”.

13. Accommodation allowance established—Regulation 29 (2) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words “secondary student and”.

14. Award of accommodation allowance—Regulation 30 of the principal regulations (as substituted by regulation 6 of the Student Allowances Regulations 1988, Amendment No. 1) is hereby amended—

(a) By revoking paragraph (a):

(b) By omitting from paragraph (c) the words "secondary student or":

(c) By omitting from paragraph (d) the words "secondary student or".

15. Student beginning to live in parental home or with spouse—Regulation 32 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

(a) By revoking subclause (3) (a):

(b) By omitting from subclause (3) (b) the words " , in any other case".

16. Revocations—(1) Regulations 3 (1) (a), 3 (2), 16 (2) (a) (ii), 18 (2) (b) (i), 22 (1) (c), and 26 of the principal regulations are hereby revoked.

(2) Regulation 2 of the Student Allowances Regulations 1988, Amendment No. 2 is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 January 1991, amend the Student Allowances Regulations 1988.

The principal effect of the regulations is to remove student allowance support for secondary school students.
