2 Commencement of Sport and Recreation New Zealand Act 2002

The Sport and Recreation New Zealand Act 2002 comes into force on 1 January 2003.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order brings into force, on 1 January 2003, the Sport and Recreation New Zealand Act 2002.

The Sport and Recreation New Zealand Act 2002 is an Act to-

- promote, encourage, and support physical recreation and sport in New Zealand by establishing an agency called Sport and Recreation New Zealand; and
- dissolve the Hillary Commission for Sport, Fitness, and Leisure; and
- repeal the Sport, Fitness, and Leisure Act 1987.
