**O R D E R**

**1. Title**—This order may be cited as the Shipping and Seamen Amendment Act Commencement Order 1970.

**2. Commencement of Part I of 1968 Amendment Act**—Part I of the Shipping and Seamen Amendment Act 1968 shall come into force on the 5th day of May 1970.
