PURSUANT to the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Shipping and Seamen Amendment Act Commencement Order 1972.

2. Commencement of sections 14, 15, and 16 of 1968 Amendment Act—Sections 14, 15, and 16 of the Shipping and Seamen Amendment Act 1968 shall come into force on the 31st day of August 1972.
