THE STOCK ACT SUSPENSION EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1942

At the Government House at Wellington, this 18th day of February, 1942.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Stock Act Suspension Emergency Regulations 1942.
- 2. So long as these regulations continue in force and notwithstanding anything to the contrary in section 52 of the Stock Act, 1908, no owner of sheep or former owner of sheep shall be required to make in respect either of sheep kept by him or of his having ceased to be an owner of sheep any of the returns prescribed by that section.
