

THE STOCK-REMEDIES ACT SUSPENSION EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1942

C. L. N. NEWALL, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 4th day of March, 1942.

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Stock-remedies Act Suspension Emergency Regulations 1942.

2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Stock-remedies Act, 1934, or in any certificate of registration in respect of a stockremedy issued under that Act, the registration of every stock-remedy effected under that Act and in force on the 30th day of September, 1942, or thereafter effected shall continue in force until the 30th day of September next after the date on which these regulations cease to be in force.
