

## THE SEAT BELTS APPROVAL NOTICE 1972

Pursuant to regulation 49 of the Traffic Regulations 1956\* (as substituted by regulation 14 (1) of the Traffic Regulations 1956, Amendment No. 7), the Secretary for Transport hereby gives the following notice.

## NOTICE

- 1. Title—This notice may be cited as the Seat Belts Approval Notice 1972.
- 2. Approval of seat belts—The following types of seat belts are hereby approved for the purposes of regulation 51B of the Traffic Regulations 1956 (as substituted by regulation 3 of the Traffic Regulations 1956, Amendment No. 22), namely:
  - (a) Seat belts bearing a standard mark as defined in section 2 of the Standards Act 1965:
  - (b) Seat belts bearing the certification mark of the British Standards Institute:
  - (c) Seat belts manufactured in Australia and bearing the standard number "E 35" of the Australian Standards Association:
    (d) Seat belts labelled or otherwise marked that they comply with
  - Federal Motor Vehicle Safety Standard No. 209 of the United States of America.
  - 3. Revocations—The following notices are hereby revoked:
  - (a) Notice by the Commissioner of Transport dated the 20th day of May 1965† approving safety belts for motor vehicles:
  - (b) Notice by the Secretary for Transport dated the 26th day of January 1972; approving safety belts for motor vehicles.
