ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 5th day of December 1977

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title**—These regulations may be cited as the School Boarding Bursaries Regulations 1972, Amendment No. 2 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the School Boarding Bursaries Regulations 1972\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

**2. Maximum annual value of bursary**—Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$400" (as substituted by regulation 2 of the School Boarding Bursaries Regulations 1972, Amendment No. 1), and substituting the expression "\$500".

**3. Transitional**—The principal regulations are hereby further amended by inserting, after regulation 4, the following regulation:

"4A. Notwithstanding regulation 4 and regulation 11 of these regulations, the maximum annual value of a bursary for the year 1977 shall be \$433, payable by instalments of \$133 each in respect of the first and second terms and \$167 in respect of the third term; and deductions from payments in respect of the third term on account of absence shall be made at the rate of \$2.50 per day."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations increase the value of a school boarding bursary from \$400 to \$500 per year, applicable to only the third term of the 1977 year.
