THE SUBMARINE CABLES AND PIPELINES PROTECTION ORDER 1979, AMENDMENT NO. 1

ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 7 of the Submarine Cables and Pipelines Protection Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Submarine Cables and Pipelines Protection Order 1979, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Submarine Cables and Pipelines Protection Order 1979* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).
- (2) This order shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Hauraki Gulf—The First Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by revoking the item "Area 2—Hauraki Gulf", and substituting the following item:

"Area 2-Hauraki Gulf

"All that area bounded by straight lines commencing at position 36° 46.81'S 174° 46.65'E, thence to 36° 39.2'S 174° 48.1'E, thence to 36° 36.5'S 174° 56.7'E, thence to 36° 24.2'S 174° 56.7'E, thence to 36° 19.9'S 174° 56.4'E, thence to 36° 06.7'S 174° 55.3'E, thence to 35° 52.5'S 174° 55.8'E,

thence to 35° 42.4′S 174° 59.9′E, thence to 35° 42.2′S 175° 07.2′E, thence to 35° 53.4′S 175° 02′E, thence to 36° 15.2′S 175° 00′E, thence to 36° 37.7′S 175° 00′E, thence to 36° 40.9′S 174° 50′E, thence to 36° 47.0′S 174° 48′E, thence to 36° 47.73′S 174° 47.26′E, thence to 36° 47.4′S 174° 46.52′E, on the shore."

3. Hawke Bay—The First Schedule to the principal order is hereby further amended by adding the following item:

"Area 11A-Hawke Bay

"All that area bounded by straight lines commencing at position 39° 34.86'S 176° 57.86'E, thence to 39° 34.76'S 176° 57.80'E, thence to 39° 34.58'S 176° 58.25'E, thence to 39° 34.70'S 176° 58.30'E, thence to the position of commencement."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order substitutes a new protected area in the Hauraki Gulf and adds a new protected area in Hawke Bay. Anchoring and fishing in protected areas is prohibited.

The revised Hauraki Gulf protected area relates to the protection of the ANZCAN cable. The previous area was approximately 3 nautical miles wide and commenced at harbour limits off Takapuna Beach and Rangitoto Island. The area within harbour limits was protected under other legislation. The new area covers a similar route but is approximately 5 nautical miles wide and includes the area within harbour limits. The area concerned begins at Takapuna Beach near Lake Pupuke and runs out past Rangitoto Island and Tiritiri Matangi Island then generally northwards to the limits of the territorial sea.

The new Hawke Bay protected area relates to the protection of the Hastings sewer outfall. It is an area off the mouth of the Tukituki River starting about 1.2 nautical miles off shore and ending about 1.6 nautical miles offshore. It is about 0.2 nautical miles wide.
