PURSUANT to section 7 of the Submarine Cables and Pipelines Protection Act 1966, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Submarine Cables and Pipelines Protection Order 1979, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Submarine Cables and Pipelines Protection Order 1979* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its

notification in the Gazette.

2. Great Barrier Island protected area reduced—The First Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by revoking the item "Area 1—Great Barrier Island", and substituting the following item:

"Area 1-Great Barrier Island

All that area bounded by a straight line drawn from the Great Barrier Island low water mark at position 36° 13.05′S 175° 29.20′E to a position 36° 12.0′S 175° 33.3′E, by a straight line to position 36° 15.1′S 175° 33.3′E, by a straight line to the Great Barrier Island low water mark at a position 36° 13.85′S 175° 28.6′E, and by the line of low water mark to the position of commencement."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force 28 days after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*, reduces the protected area in the vicinity of Great Barrier Island. Anchoring and fishing in the protected area is prohibited.
