

THE SCHOOL COMMITTEES ADMINISTRATION REGULATIONS 1965, AMENDMENT NO. 7

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 5th day of April 1982

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the School Committees Administration Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 7, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the School Committees Administration Regulations 1965* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Elections to be held at biennial meetings—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 20 (as substituted by regulation 9 of the School Committees Administration Regulations 1965, Amendment No. 3), and substituting the following regulation:

"20. (1) Subject to subclause (2) of this regulation, an election of the members of the School Committee of an intermediate school shall be held in 1983, and in every second year thereafter, at the biennial meeting of electors on—

"(a) The last Wednesday in March; or

"(b) Such earlier day (not being earlier than the 14th day of March) as the Board fixes in that behalf.

"(2) If, at the date of the first biennial meeting of electors of a newly established intermediate school,-

"(a) The members of that school's School Committee; or

"(b) The members of a Committee convened under regulation 22 of these regulations—

have been in office for less than 1 year, subject to the Act those members shall continue to hold office until the election of a new Committee at the following biennial meeting."

(2) Regulation 9 of the School Committees Administration Regulations

1965, Amendment No. 3 is hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations move from the first week of May to the second half of March the date for the biennial election of School Committees for intermediate schools.
