Pursuant to the Stock Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Sausage Casing Importation Regulations 1938, Amendment No. 4, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Sausage Casing Importation Regulations 1938* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Clause 11 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "in the Form No. 3 in the Schedule hereto".
- 3. The Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking Form No. 3.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations do away with the necessity for a permit to land sausage casings to be in a prescribed form, and allow an Inspector to use any appropriate written form of authority.
