ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 29th day of February 1956

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Samoa Act 1921, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Samoa Customs Order 1939, Amendment No. 5, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Samoa Customs Order 1939* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

2. Clause 19 of the principal order (as amended by clause 5 of the Samoa Customs Order 1939, Amendment No. 1) is hereby further amended by revoking subclause (1), and substituting the following subclause:

"(1) There shall be levied, collected, and paid to the use of Her Majesty on goods imported into Samoa the several duties of Customs set out in the Second Schedule hereto."

3. The Samoa Customs Order 1939, Amendment No. 2, is hereby amended by revoking clauses 4, 5, and 6.

4. The Samoa Customs Order 1939, Amendment No. 4, and the Samoa Port and Service Tax Amendment Order 1931⁺ are hereby revoked.
