THE SAMOA CUSTOMS ORDER AMENDMENT ORDINANCE 1950

1950 No. 3

AN ORDINANCE

To Amend the Samoa Customs Order 1939.

(18th October, 1950)

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislative Assembly of Western Samoa upon the recommendation of the High Commissioner as follows:—

1. Short Title.—This Ordinance may be cited as the Samoa Customs Order Amendment Ordinance 1950 and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Samoa Customs Order 1939* (hereinafter referred to as the Order).

2. Additional exemption.—The Second Schedule to the Order (as amended by the Samoa Customs Order 1939, Amendment No. 2) is hereby further amended by adding under the heading of Exemptions the following item:—

“(27) Margarine ”

3. Increasing rate of export duty on cocoa beans, &c.—The Third Schedule to the Order (as substituted by the Samoa Customs Order 1939, Amendment No. 4) is hereby amended by revoking the items numbered 2 and 3 thereof, and substituting the following:—

“ Tariff No.	Goods.	Rate of Duty.
2	Cocoa beans	10 per cent <i>ad valorem</i> .
3	Extracts from or preparations of cocoa beans	10 per cent <i>ad valorem</i> of the cocoa beans used in the extract or preparation.”

Passed in Assembly this eighteenth day of October, nineteen hundred and fifty.
