ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 43 of the Small Claims Tribunals Act 1976, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following rules.

RULES

1. Title and commencement—(1) These rules may be cited as the Small Claims Tribunals Rules 1977, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Small Claims Tribunals Rules 1977* (hereinafter referred to as the principal rules).

(2) These rules shall come into force on the 11th day of April 1988.

2. Fee for lodging of claim increased—(1) Rule 13 (2) of the principal rules (as amended by rule 2 of the Small Claims Tribunals Rules 1977, Amendment No. 1) is hereby amended by omitting the expression “\$5”, and substituting the expression “\$5.50”.

(2) The Small Claims Tribunals Rules 1977, Amendment No. 1 are hereby consequentially revoked.

3. Amount of goods and services tax included—The fee fixed by these rules is inclusive of goods and services tax under the Goods and Services Tax Act 1985.

This note is not part of the rules, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These rules increase from \$5 to \$5.50 the fee payable on the lodging of a claim before a Small Claims Tribunal.
