THE STAMP DUTIES EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1939.

GALWAY, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 13th day of December, 1939.

Pursuant to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Stamp Duties Emergency Regulations 1939.
- 2. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Stamp Duties Act, 1923, no stamp duty shall be payable on a power of attorney executed by any person who is actually performing naval, military, or air service in connection with the present war in New Zealand or elsewhere, or which is executed by any person prior to and in anticipation of his performance of such service.
- 3. These regulations shall apply to all powers of attorney executed as aforesaid after the 3rd day of September, 1939.
