**THE STAMP DUTIES EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1939,
AMENDMENT NO. 5**

Present :

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Stamp Duties Emergency Regulations 1939, Amendment No. 5.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed part of the Stamp Duties Emergency Regulations 1939* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. The principal regulations are hereby amended by adding thereto the following additional regulation:—

“ 8. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in the Stamp Duties Act, 1923, no stamp duty shall be payable on any declaration under the Justices of the Peace Act, 1927, required for the purposes of the Second New Zealand Expeditionary Force Pay and Allowances Emergency Regulations 1941†, or the Home Defence Pay and Allowances Emergency Regulations 1941‡, or any regulations enacted in substitution therefor.”
