ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 16th day of July 1952

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Stock Act 1908, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following Order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Stock Diseases Order 1952.
2. The disease known as scrapie is hereby declared to be a disease for the purposes of the Stock Act 1908 and the Stock Diseases Regulations 1937.*
