### ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 2(5) of the Secondhand Dealers Act 1963, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### ORDER

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) This order may be cited as the Secondhand Dealers Order 1964, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Secondhand Dealers Order 1964\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

(2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Schedule amended**—The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by adding the following item:

“4. Used aluminium beverage cans.”

This order excludes used aluminium beverage cans from the provisions of the Secondhand Dealers Act 1963.
