#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 2 (5) of the Secondhand Dealers Act 1963, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

## ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Secondhand Dealers Order 1964, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Secondhand Dealers Order 1964\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).
- (2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- **2. Schedule amended**—The Schedule to the principal order is hereby amended by adding the following item:
  - "4. Used aluminium beverage cans."

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order excludes used aluminium beverage cans from the provisions of the Secondhand Dealers Act 1963.
