ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 228 (2) (b) of the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Shipping (Maximum Duration of Certificates of Survey) Order 1988.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Maximum duration of certain certificates of survey—(1) Subject to subclause (2) of this clause, the maximum period for which a certificate of survey may be issued under section 219 of the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952 is 5 years.

(2) Subclause (1) of this clause applies to New Zealand ships and coastal ships that are not—

- (a) Passenger ships; or
- (b) Restricted-limit ships; or
- (c) Fishing vessels.
