#### ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 29th day of February 1988

#### Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to section 228 (2) (b) of the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

### **ORDER**

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Shipping (Maximum Duration of Certificates of Survey) Order 1988.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the Gazette.
- 2. Maximum duration of certain certificates of survey—(1) Subject to subclause (2) of this clause, the maximum period for which a certificate of survey may be issued under section 219 of the Shipping and Seamen Act 1952 is 5 years.
- (2) Subclause (1) of this clause applies to New Zealand ships and coastal ships that are not—
  - (a) Passenger ships; or
  - (b) Restricted-limit ships; or
  - (c) Fishing vessels.
