**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

PURSUANT to the Animals Act 1967, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

---

**REGULATIONS**

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Stock Diseases Regulations 1937, Amendment No. 6, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Stock Diseases Regulations 1937\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

**2. Feeding of garbage to swine and poultry**—Regulation 6 of the principal regulations is hereby amended—

(a) By omitting from subclause (1) the expression “212° Fahrenheit (100° Centigrade)”, and substituting the expression “100° Celsius”:

(b) By omitting from subparagraph (i) and subparagraph (ii) of paragraph (b) of subclause (8) the expression “40 gallons”, and substituting in each case the expression “200 litres”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations amend the principal regulations by converting references to degrees Fahrenheit and Centigrade to a reference to degrees Celsius; also by converting references to gallons to references to litres.
