THE SECONDHAND DEALERS REGULATIONS 1963, AMENDMENT NO. 3

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL BY HIS DEPUTY IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to section 23 of the Secondhand Dealers Act 1963, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Secondhand Dealers Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 3, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Secondhand Dealers Regulations 1963* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 17th day of August 1981.
- 2. Fee for duplicate licence increased—Regulation 10 of the principal regulations (as amended by regulation 2 (1) of the Secondhand Dealers Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 1) is hereby amended by omitting the expression "\$5", and substituting the expression "\$10".
- **3. Prescribed fees**—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 11, and substituting the following regulation:
- "11. (1) Where a secondhand dealer's licence is issued in respect of a settled place of business only, the fee for the licence shall be \$75.
- "(2) Where a secondhand dealer's licence is issued in respect of both a settled place of business and itinerant dealing, the fee for the licence shall be \$100.

- "(3) If an application for a licence is refused or withdrawn, the applicant shall be entitled to a refund of part of the fee as follows:
 - '(a) Where the application relates to a settled place of business only, a refund of \$60:
 - "(b) Where the application relates to both a settled place of business and itinerant dealing, a refund of \$85."
- **4. Revocations**—The Secondhand Dealers Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 1 and the Secondhand Dealers Regulations 1963, Amendment No. 2 are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations increase—

(a) From \$5 to \$10 the fee payable for a duplicate licence:

(b) From \$50 to \$75 the fee payable for a licence in respect of a settled place of business only, with a consequential increase from \$45 to \$60 in the amount refunded where an application for such a licence is declined or withdrawn:

(c) From \$75 to \$100 the fee payable for a licence in respect of a settled place of business and itinerant dealing, with a consequential increase from \$70 to \$85 in the amount refunded where an application for such a licence is declined or withdrawn.
