Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL
PURSUANT to section 28 (1) (e) of the State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986, His
Excellency the Administrator of the Government, acting by and with the
advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following
order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the State-Owned Enterprises (Development Levy) Order 1990.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Sections of Local Government Act 1974 not to apply—Sections 294 to 294I of the Local Government Act 1974 (which relate to reserve contributions, development levies, and contributions to certain regional works) shall not apply to the Clyde Dam Development Project, being the dam constructed pursuant to the right conferred by section 3 (1) (a) of the Clutha Development (Clyde Dam) Empowering Act 1982.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order provides that sections 294 to 294₁ of the Local Government Act 1974 (which relate to reserve contributions, development levies, and contributions to certain regional works) are not to apply to the Clyde Dam Development Project.
